Are YOU Eligible to Join The Sons of The American Legion

You can become a member of the Sons of The American Legion if:

From the National Constitution of the Sons of The American Legion, Article IV, Section 1: All male descendents, adopted sons and stepsons of members of The American Legion and such male descendants of veterans who died in service during World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Lebanon, Grenada, Panama and the Persian Gulf War, during the delimiting periods set forth in Article IV, Section 1, of the National Constitution of The American Legion, or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of The American Legion.

Eligibility Dates for Membership in The American Legion

April 6, 1917 to November 11, 1918 (World War I) December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946 (World War II) June 25, 1950 to January 31, 1955 (Korean War) February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975 (Vietnam War) August 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984 (Lebanon/Grenada) December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990 (Panama) August 2, 1990 to today (Gulf War/War On Terrorism)

The above dates apply to the veteran through which a Sons of The American Legion member is establishing eligibility.
